Insurance and Fees

MAPS accepts most insurances, including Medical Assistance and Medicare. MAPS participates in most managed care networks.

MAPS requests that payment be made when services are rendered. Methods of payment include: cash, check, VISA or MasterCard. If MAPS is a participating provider with an individual's insurance or managed care plan, MAPS may be able to bill for services exclusive of co-payment obligations. In that situation, the co-payment will be due at the time of treatment. A copy of our fee schedule is available upon request.
