Hidden River Clubhouse is here to help you get back on your feet. We drive our members toward Transitional, Supported & Independent Employment so they can work, grow and thrive in their community. We serve Schuylkill County adults living with mental illness to support working and independent living.



What We Do.

Members at Hidden River Clubhouse work side-by-side with peers & trained psychiatric rehabilitation staff to learn social, vocational, & independent living skills in an engaging & welcoming environment. Members participate in a Work-Ordered Day, where they attend meetings, perform administrative duties, prepare meals, learn maintenance tasks, create social media content, along with a variety of other skill-building tasks.

How It Works.

- A Member Run Community: Members make the Clubhouse. All aspects of Clubhouse are member driven, voted, & supported.
- Social and Vocational Support: The Clubhouse hosts evening, weekend, & holiday socials to foster meaningful relationships with peers in their community. Clubhouse also hosts Transitional Employment opportunities, where staff and members work side-by-side at the job site to build skills & learn to utilize coping skills in the moment.
- Autonomy: Membership is always voluntary & without time limits. Members choose when they attend, & how they utilize services.
 Members have full involvement in creating and implementing their goal plans & rehabilitation at the Clubhouse.

Accessing Services.

- Who is eligible for clubhouse membership? Schuylkill County adults (18+) with a severe mental illness diagnosis.
- How is membership funded? Membership is primarily funded by member's insurance. Out of Pocket options are also available.
- How do I get started? Reach out to CSG or Hidden River at any time, or start a conversation with your mental health professionals!
